

PASTOR'S CORNER

My dear parishioners and friends,

As we celebrate today the Feast of the Dedication of the Lateran Basilica in Rome, we are reminded not only of its great significance in the history of the Catholic Church but also of the importance of keeping our places of worship truly sacred and treated with reverence. The Lateran Basilica, known as the Mother and Head of all churches of the City and the World, reminds us that every church building, no matter how simple or grand, is a visible sign of God's dwelling among His people. 

