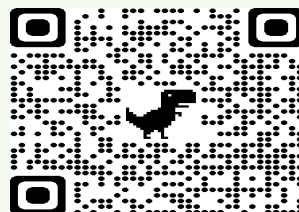

Two important programs are about to begin:

Adult Theology Classes

Beginning Thursday, September 11, 2025

We are excited to announce that Theology Classes will begin on Thursday, September 11, 2025. Classes will meet every Thursday for one hour, running from September 2025 through May 2026.

In these sessions, Tom Collucci will guide us in exploring and deepening our Catholic faith through the Catechism of the Catholic Church, the documents of the Second Vatican Council, other Church writings, and Sacred Scripture.

This is a wonderful opportunity for adults to grow in knowledge and love of the faith. All that is asked is your presence, participation, and openness to the readings and assignments.

Religious Education (CCD)

Beginning Sunday, September 21, 2025

We give thanks to the eight parishioners who have generously stepped forward to serve as catechists. While not all can begin right away, their willingness already brings new life to our program. Because of them, and with the steadfast dedication of our current catechists and DREs, our CCD classes will resume on Sunday, September 21, 2025.

Meanwhile, we ask our parish community to keep two important needs in mind before classes begin:

Religious education is not only about preparing for the sacraments of First Communion or Confirmation. It is a lifelong formation that builds each year from Grade 1 through Grade 8. Every Catholic child should be enrolled in religious education annually, alongside their academic learning.

ARCHDIOCESE PILGRIMAGE JUBILEE 2025

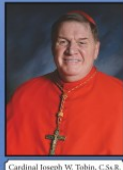

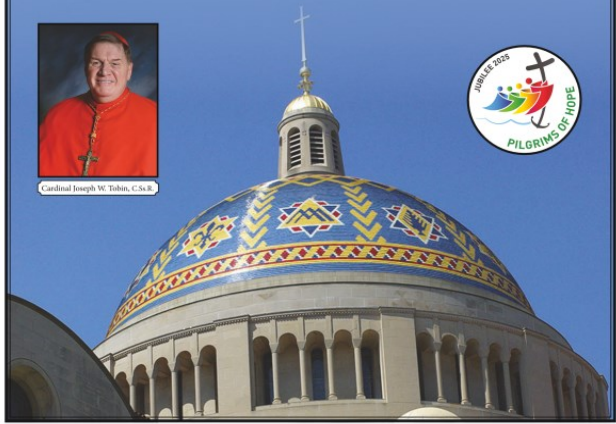
