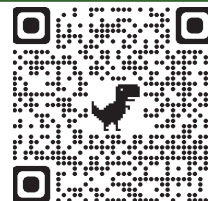

From the desk of the Administrator...

Dear parishioners and friends,

It is with pleasure that I announce that the new sets of officers of both finance and pastoral councils are now complete. In the succeeding weeks, the officers will introduce themselves individually in the bulletin. In the meantime, their names are listed herein. Below is an overview of the functions and tasks of both councils.

The Pastoral Council is responsible in assisting the Pastor with the pastoral life and worship ministries of the parish. It oversees, assists, and coordinates the programs and activities that the various ministries plan and execute, to enhance the physical, psychological and spiritual well-being of everyone in the parish. There are currently 17 ministries under three categories that are derived from the three-fold roles of Christ – Priestly, Prophetic and Kingly – and they are worship, education, and service. In addition are two special and yet equally important ministries - youth and children.

The Finance Council is responsible in assisting the Pastor with parish financial administration, specifically in the administration of temporal goods. It discusses and takes action with regards properties, buildings, and other finances of the parish. It also acts as an advisory body on legal aspects. There are currently three committees which study and recommend to the council their plans for deliberation and approval, before final execution.

While the Pastoral Council is representative of the entire parish membership, the Finance Council is composed of experts in finance, civil law and business practices. Both councils have had their meetings these past two weeks. Many concerns and issues were presented and discussed, and one of the most pressing concerns of the Finance Council was the report of the previous fiscal year, which will be outlined in one of our Sunday masses. The Finance Council also addressed other pertinent concerns like our properties for lease, church building repairs, and the current fund-raising campaign for the 120th Foundation Day. Similarly, the Pastoral Council discussed the formation of new ministries, and upcoming programs and activities; foremost among them is the Parish Mission to be held from October 24 to 27. This Parish Mission is the spiritual component of our 120th Foundation Day celebration. Just as we are actively preparing for the October 30th event, we likewise need to prepare ourselves spiritually through attendance and participation in the Parish Mission. I strongly urge everyone to attend and invite your friends from within and outside the parish.

May the Lord bless the work of our hands!
