PASTOR'S CORNER

My dear parishioners and friends,

As we celebrate this Fourth Sunday of Advent, we light the fourth candle, symbolizing LOVE—the love that is perfectly revealed and incarnated in our Lord Jesus Christ.

Christmas is only four days away. On this holy day, we commemorate the birth of Jesus, who is Emmanuel—God with us. His birth not only brings hope, peace, and joy; most of all, it brings God, who is Love, into our world and into our lives.

When Love entered the world through God's only begotten Son, Jesus Christ, it marked the beginning of our redemption. Having been separated from paradise by sin, it was God who took the first step toward us. In the humility of the Incarnation, He chose the Blessed Virgin Mary to be the vessel of His coming—a young woman whose faithful “yes” opened the door for salvation to unfold.

To complete our redemption, Jesus obediently embraced His mission—offering His life on the cross and rising from the dead. May this love move us to forgive where there is hurt, to reach out where there is need, and to welcome Christ in one another.

May the love of Emmanuel dwell with you and your families, within our parish community of St. Anthony, and beyond, as we joyfully await His birth.
