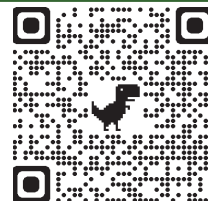

* Mobile App (VANCO Mobile Faith Engagement) available at App Store or Play Store *

1. **Visit** St. Anthony's website

2. **Click the link** to go to our e-Giving webpage or use this QR code.



3. If this is your first time, **click "Create Profile"**

4. Enter you email address, twice, then **click "Continue"**

5. Setup your profile page, including name and address, then create a password.

Notice the password requirements: at least eight characters, including at least one letter and one number, etc.

Then, **click "Create Profile"**

6. You will be at the Online Donation page.

This will be your landing page going forward after login.

Click "Add Transaction"

7. Start entering your contributions. You can donate just this week, or set it up for future weeks. You can even select "weekly" or "Monthly" if you desire, and it will continue until you stop it.

NOTE: When selecting the start date, it cannot be a weekend or a holiday. Choose the Friday before or the Monday after.

8. Once complete, scroll down to **click "Continue"**

9. On the Donation Information screen, enter your envelope number for tracking, then select Credit, Checking, or Savings. Complete the fields requested. **Click "Process"** when satisfied.

10. Your confirmation screen will appear next

From here, you can **click "Log Off"**

NOTE: You will receive a receipt via email from "ereceipt@eservicepayments.com."

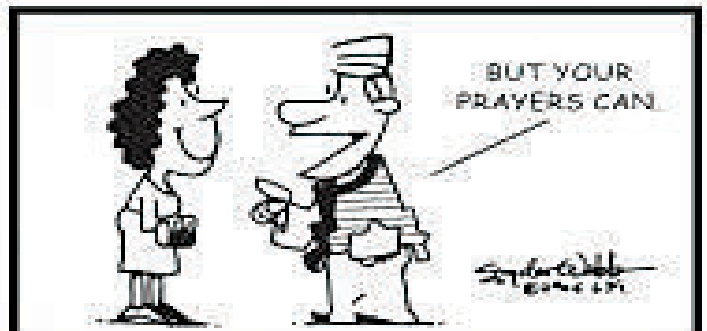
