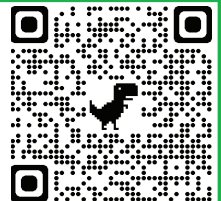

POPE FRANCIS' REMINDERS FOR THESE SUMMER MONTHS OF 2023

On Grandparents and the Elderly

Pope Francis has asked the Catholic Church to pray in a special way for the elderly during the month of July.

"We cannot speak about family without talking about the importance of the elderly among us. We elderly people often have a special sensitivity for care, for reflection, and affection. We are, or we can become, teachers of tenderness."

"We pray for the elderly, who represent the roots and memory of a people, that their experience and wisdom will help those who are younger to look to the future with hope and responsibility."

"In this world accustomed to war, we need a true revolution of tenderness. We have a great responsibility towards new generations about this."

"Let us remember: grandparents and the elderly are the bread that nourishes our lives, the hidden wisdom of a people. That is why we must celebrate them, and I have established a day dedicated to them."

The 3rd World Day for Grandparents and the Elderly will be celebrated on July 23, 2023.

On Youth and the World Youth Day

With less than three months to go to World Youth Day (WYD), Pope Francis has sent his encouragement to participants registered for the event in Lisbon, Portugal.

"I can imagine the things you must have on your mind, how you're going to: make it happen, request your work or study permit, get what you need for your trip, so many concerns! Prepare yourselves with that enthusiasm. Have hope because one grows a lot at an event like WYD."

"In order to prepare well, it helps to look to your roots by meeting with your elders, such as grandparents. Participants in the upcoming WYD in Lisbon should ask their grandparents: 'What do you think I must do?' Our elders will give you wisdom."

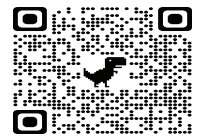

ARRIVING LATE AT MASS & COMMUNION

(a repost from September 5, 2021 bulletin)

Mass begins with the entrance procession and ends after the final dismissal and we should be there from beginning to end.

Although there is no legal prohibition on the baptized persons receiving Communion if they have come to Mass late, it is *desirable and highly encouraged* that they come on time and participate the Mass in full.

Arriving on time is not just a question of obligation but of love and respect for Our Lord who has gathered us together to share his gifts, and who has some grace to communicate to us in each part of the Mass.

It is also a sign of respect for the community with whom we worship and who deserves our presence and the contribution of our prayers in each moment. The liturgy is essentially the worship of Christ's body, the Church. Each assembly is called upon to represent and manifest the whole body but this can hardly happen if it forms itself in drips and drabs after the celebration has begun.

Although those who arrive late in Mass may not be denied Communion, they should examine their conscience as to the reason behind their tardiness. If the reason is culpable negligence and laziness, and *especially if they do so habitually*, then they need to seriously reflect on their attitudes, amend their ways, and if necessary seek the sacrament of reconciliation. Needless to say, they are therefore discouraged to receive communion and would do better attending another full Mass if this is possible. Even those who blamelessly arrive late should prefer to assist at a full Mass although they would be less bound to do so in conscience.

But, if they come late with a *valid reason* (for example, an unusual traffic jam, attending sick children, etc.), they may opt to receive Communion, unless they are not properly disposed.

It is true that Communion may be received outside of Mass, so Mass is not an essential prerequisite for receiving Communion, especially if one is ill. This would not, however, justify arriving late or just in time for Communion at Mass, as all of the rites for receiving Communion outside
