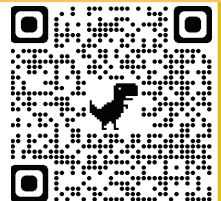

OUR LADY OF FATIMA

Our Lady of Fatima is a Marian apparition who appeared to three shepherd children in Cova da Iria, Portugal, on six occasions between May and October of 1917. During her initial appearances, Mary showed three prophetic visions to the children and urged them to pray the rosary daily for world peace and sinners' salvation. During her final apparition on Oct. 13, thousands of people observed what is now known as the Miracle of the Sun – the sight of the sun zig-zagging through the sky.

Three decades later, the original Pilgrim Statue of Our Lady of Fatima was created by sculptor Jose Ferreira Thedim using a detailed description provided by one of the children who saw her, Sister Lucia dos Santos. This statue was eventually duplicated multiple times and has traveled across the world to bring Our Lady to those who cannot visit the Shrine of Fatima.

A Pilgrim Statue of Our Lady of Fatima – which has traveled the world on a mission to spread peace and hope since 1947 – will visit to a dozen parishes of the Archdiocese of Newark from April 28 through May 31.

This archdiocesan tour of the statue is intended for parishioners to thank Our Lady for her protection during the COVID-19 pandemic and request her intercession amidst current global conflicts. It is also meant to generate excitement for the Catholic Church's World Youth Day festival, which will take place in Lisbon, Portugal, from Aug. 1-6.

As announced in the previous bulletins, our Parish will host this Pilgrim Statue of Our Lady of Fatima for two days, May 22 & 23 (Monday & Tuesday). Everyone is invited to meet Mother Mary's image and ask her constant intercessions for the needs of the world and our own needs.

The following is the schedule of activities during the visit:

May 22 (Monday)

1pm – ETA (coming from St. James the Apostle Parish in Springfield)
1:30pm – Holy Rosary (led by the Rosary Altar Society)
2:00pm – Reflection and Meditation of Our Lady's Message
2:30pm – Holy Rosary (individual or group prayers)
5:30pm – Reflection and Meditation of Our Lady's Message
6:00pm – Healing Mass (anointing of the sick)
(some priests will concelebrate and, after the homily, will administer the sacrament of holy anointing for those sick who wish to receive it)
7:30pm – Holy Rosary (individual or group prayers)
8:30pm – Short Movie (about Our Lady of Fatima)
9:30 pm – Night Prayer

May 23 (Tuesday)

7:00am – Mass
8:00am – Mass (with Novena to St. Anthony of Padua)
8:30am – Veneration of St. Anthony's Relic
8:45am – Start of Eucharistic Adoration (in the Church)
(individual or group rosary may be recited during the adoration)
1pm – ETD of the Statue (going to Holy Cross Parish in Harrison)

Our Tuesday Eucharistic Adoration continues as usual until 730pm.
