

Please call 973-481-1991 to receive this sacrament. We will also gladly bring Holy Communion to the homebound upon request.



# *A Message from Pope Francis*

## *Words of Challenge and Hope*

*A selection from Evangelii Gaudium (the Joy of the Gospel), Chapter V., “Spirit-filled Evangelizers”*

259. Spirit-filled evangelizers means evangelizers fearlessly open to the working of the Holy Spirit. At Pentecost, the Spirit made the apostles go forth from themselves and turned them into heralds of God's wondrous deeds, capable of speaking to each person in his or her own language. The Holy Spirit also grants the courage to proclaim the newness of the Gospel with boldness (*parrhesia*) in every time and place, even when it meets with opposition. Let us call upon him today, firmly rooted in prayer, for without prayer all our activity risks being fruitless and our message empty. Jesus wants evangelizers who proclaim the good news not only with words, but above all by a life transfigured by God's presence.

260. In this final chapter, I do not intend to offer a synthesis of Christian spirituality, or to explore great themes like prayer, Eucharistic adoration or the liturgical celebration of the faith. For all these we already have valuable texts of the magisterium and celebrated writings by great authors. I do not claim to replace or improve upon these treasures. I simply wish to offer some thoughts about the spirit of the new evangelization.

261. Whenever we say that something is “spirited”, it usually refers to some interior impulse which encourages, motivates, nourishes and gives meaning to our individual and communal activity. Spirit-filled evangelization is not the same as a set of tasks dutifully carried out despite one's own personal inclinations and wishes. How I long to find the right words to stir up enthusiasm for a new chapter of evangelization full of fervor, joy, generosity, courage, boundless love and attraction! Yet I realize that no words of encouragement will be enough unless the fire of the Holy Spirit burns in our hearts. A spirit-filled evangelization is one guided by the Holy Spirit, for He is the soul of the Church called to proclaim the Gospel. Before offering some spiritual motivations and suggestions, I once more invoke the Holy Spirit. I implore him to come and renew the Church, to stir and impel her to go forth boldly to evangelize all peoples.



### **WE REMEMBER SR. GLORIA DORIA, MPF**



#### **Went Home With Her Lord and Savior on August 5, 2023**

Born in New York City, NY, and raised in Bayonne, NJ, Sr. Gloria entered the Religious Teachers Filippini in 1948. She received the habit in 1949 and made her religious profession in 1952. Sr. Gloria earned her BS and MS in Secondary Education from St. John University, Jamaica, NY. In her 74 years of religious life, Sr. Gloria ministered as classroom teacher, Vice-Principal, and Principal. She served in the Diocese of Brooklyn and the Archdiocese of Newark. In 1996, Sr. Gloria was appointed by the Archdiocese of Newark to serve a two-year term on the Archdiocese's Parish Assistance Committee. She came to work as receptionist at St. Anthony's in 2012 and served in this parish until her death.

After having served at many different Parish Convents Sr. Gloria was appointed as Superior at the Convent at Holy Family Parish at the time of her passing. She lived at the convent with her Filippini Sisters in Christ and was blessed to have her biological sister, Sr. Beatrice, live with her as well. Sr. Beatrice has written a Thank You letter to us:
